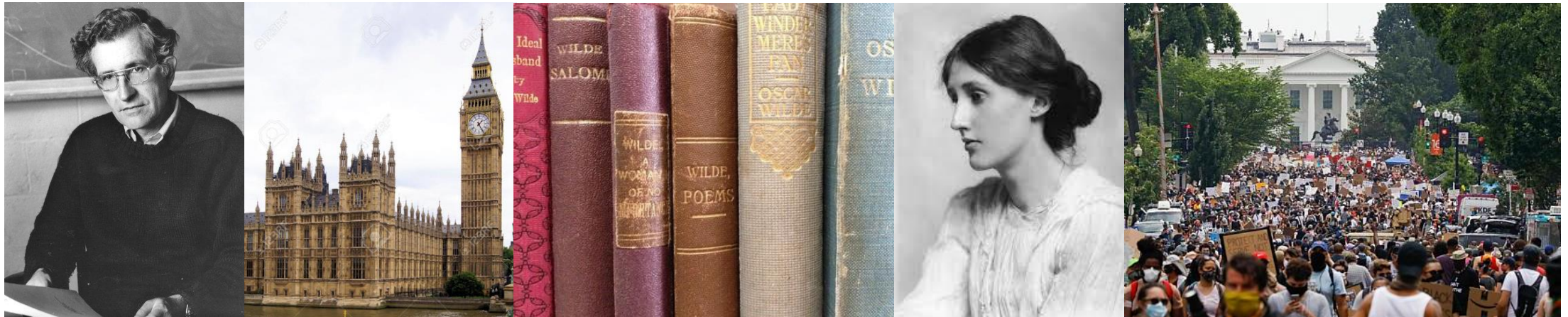

Specializations

- You have to choose **2 out of the 4** specializations and **do all three courses** for them
 1. Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL)
 2. Digital English Linguistics
 3. English Literatures
 4. Comparing Societies, Politics, and Cultures in Anglophone Countries
- You can attend more than two if you're unsure what to choose **but can only take exams in two** of them.
- As soon as you've taken one exam you have to stick with this specialization.

Translation vs. German

- If German is not your native language and you don't feel comfortable enough with your German level to translate English-German, you can take a German course instead of Translation for "Basismodul Translation Skills".
 - German classes are available through the Sprachenzentrum (see below)
- If classes are full, you will have to take the course in a later semester.

Exams

- PVL: Prüfungsvorleistung
 - not graded, just pass/fail
 - can be repeated as often as needed
- PL: Prüfungsleistung
 - graded
 - can be repeated a maximum of three times (in case of fail)

You need to register through the SB-Service!

Exams

- **!** Course enrollment does not mean exam registration **!**
- Central examination period after lectures
- WS 24/25: 10 February – 7 March 2025
- Registration: Two-week period (usually in December) via SB-Service




