 - Communicating unethical practices in science communication
 - Linguistic positivity (e.g., positive spins in titles and abstracts)
- Problems of good will
 - How to convey the idea that science serves the common good
 - Issues of transfer (e.g., policy recommendations)

Submission Guidelines

We welcome submissions from researchers at all stages of their careers.

The number of contributions is limited to: two organizers and four researchers (PhD students, promising MA students, or experienced researchers) from the University of Zaragoza and six participants from Chemnitz University of Technology.

Abstracts should be around 200 words and outline the background, research question/aim, methodology, and main findings of your research. Please also include the title of the presentation as well as the author(s) name(s), affiliation(s), and email(s).
